Maths

Any help at home and out and about using counting, rounding up or down, and vocabulary about different 2D/ 3D shapes and various ways to measure length, weight etc would be great.

SMSC/ Careers

This term we will be looking into possible jobs and college courses for the future. We are also visited by the careers department who will be looking at the future, including application forms and CV writing. In addition, we will continue our work with the HOPE project, with a particular focus on keeping ourselves safe online, especially via social media.

CoPE

We will continue working on our ASDAN Certificate of Personal Effectiveness, through different challenges at school and in the community. We are continuing to work with Rufford Park this half term, to develop and build the sensory garden and then after the holiday we will be continuing our Team Enterprise project, cooking lunches for staff. We are also working with Newark Sports and Fitness Centre where the class are developing their skills in coaching, and work with the staff at Active4Today and younger students in a variety of sports.

The students also use the media to discuss issues that directly affect them in their community and things that have consequences for the wider world. Any opportunity to watch the news together or discuss current events would be appreciated.

As we move through the summer term, we will focus on supporting students with transition. This will be through continued visits to various colleges and other options that are available to our students.
