

Maths

We will continue to work on number recognition, adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. We will also be focusing on positional language and movement. As always at home you can work on applying maths skills in real life settings such as when out shopping, cooking and telling the time. You can use websites like <https://www.topmarks.co.uk> for great interactive games.

English

This term we will be reading The Diary of a Wimpy Kid by Jeff Kinney as a class. We will be looking at character, plot and setting but also focusing on letter writing skills, diary entries and recounts.

At home, look at a range of books and read together or encourage your child to read by themselves. Talk about the passing of time and when you did certain things naming the day and ordering the days of the week. Start your own journal or diary writing about the things you do together. Play a range of different letter and alphabet games, naming objects and their letter sound.

History

We will be looking at the passing of time and researching key figures in history and their achievements. Our focus will be on Alexander Fleming and Florence Nightingale.

RE

This term we will look at how different religions and people express their beliefs and spirituality. Look at different religious buildings in your area and explore the inside.

PE

We will be completing a range of outdoor activities this term including orienteering. Play outside in the park, explore your local area learn how to navigate around town.

DT

We will be designing and creating our own model home this term. Look around your house at different rooms and their function and the overall layout.



Science

This term we will be learning about the Earth's geology and the impact of man-made materials. Look for different types of stone and start to make a collection. Go on a litter hunt, tidying your local area and looking at the impact of materials such as plastic at a local level.

Computing

We will be learning about different forms of technology that we use outside of school in everyday life and focusing on how to use a camera. Get outside and explore your local area taking a range of different pictures from different perspectives and put together a scrap book

MFL

Our focus will be learning simple French directions. We will learn to give and follow simple instructions to our peers and when controlling a BeeBot.

Music

We will be singing various songs and combining different sounds from a variety of instruments to make soundscapes to known and unknown songs.

Geography

L7 will be learning about life on the farm this term. We will be looking at and researching different animals and their young and hopefully organising a trip to a local farm to feed and handle the animals.
