

Maths

We will continue to work on securing our understanding of number and of addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. We will also look at fractions and decimals and measure. Follow simple recipes measuring out ingredients and using scales to read measures. Talk about simple sharing such as half of certain quantities and divide things equally between a number of family members.

History / Geography

We will be looking at Roman history. Research Roman facts, look at pictures of Roman soldiers and try to dress as one.

RE

Our RE topic is family and community. Discuss family members and draw a family tree to help pupils understand relationships to others and how they connected.

PE

In PE we will be continuing to develop our personal fitness as well as focusing on lacrosse. Play simple bat and ball games and agree on rules to follow. Discuss the idea of winning and losing, taking turns and co-operating.

DT

Our DT topic is linked to Geography where we will making foods from different European countries. Cook together at home.

English

You can continue to access the schools online reading portal to read a range of appropriate books aimed specifically at each pupil. Contact me if you have misplaced your log in details.

We will also be looking at how to give and receive instructions in a range of different activities such as when following a recipe, programming simple electronic devices or during PE. In addition, we will be focussing on structuring verbal and written sentences correctly, using full stops and capitals letters, extending sentences through the use of connectives and introducing adjectives to make our writing more interesting to the reader. At home look for and use instructions in practical situations such as following recipes and playing games.



Science

This term we will be looking at Earth and Space and Forces around us. Look at the position of the sun and draw around your shadow. Look at how the shadows change throughout the day. Examine the changing moon each night. Draw pictures of what it looks like over the course of a month.

Citizenship

We are looking at rules in school and how they are decided. Make a list of rules that are used at home and discuss why they are in place.

Geography

In Geography we are looking at Europe. Look at maps together and discuss places you have visited.

Computing

This term we will be looking at how to stay safe online. We will focus on understanding what our personal details are and when and who we should and shouldn't share them with. The Childline website has lots of great resources and videos to watch together and look out for the Parentline magazine we will be sending home soon.

MFL

In French our topic is greetings and personal details. Look at where you live and to enable pupils to name their town or village and street.

Relationships

We are looking at friendship. Practice social skills such as turn taking during board games and talk
