


## Homework ideas for L5 - Autumn 2018

<p>Literacy</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Please read with your child at least 4x a week + sign the reading diary. We have a reward chart in class and check the dairies on a regular basis. You can read the books that we send home from school, or suitable books that you have at home.</li> <li>- Spelling/handwriting - your child has a spelling/handwriting booklet with their individual set of spelling words or letters/name to practise. Your child can practise this inside the book, or on a separate piece of paper. It is lovely if they could bring their work in to show us! <p>Maths</p> 	<p>Things to practise with your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Using clocks to tell the time.</li> <li>- Saying the days of the week, names of the months.</li> <li>- Counting steps, trees, cars.</li> <li>- Looking for numbers in shops, recognising numerals.</li> <li>- Laying the table and working out how many plates, forks, etc. you need.</li> <li>- Counting in twos, fives and tens.</li> <li>- Counting backwards and forwards.</li> <li>- Looking at money and letting your child have a go at paying for something in a shop.</li> <li>- Baking cakes with your child and letting them measure out the ingredients on the scales.</li> <li>- Spotting shapes and patterns when you are out and about (circles, rectangles, cubes, etc).</li> <li>- Website with lots of games: <a href="http://www.topmarks.co.uk">www.topmarks.co.uk</a></li> </ul>
