

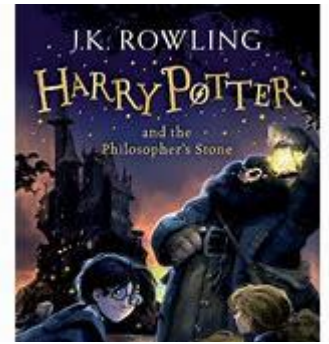
L6 Newsletter
