During Autumn term H1's topic is 'Minibeasts and animals'! We will be reading a range of minibeast related poetry, stories and looking at Non-Fiction texts as we learn and explore the human life cycle.

Could you create your own junk model minibeast or animal using a range of shapes and different items of recycling? What shapes can you see?

Can you draw a picture of your favourite minibeast and write the initial sound next to it, or write a sentence?

E.g. 'b' for Bumblebee.

Or 'I love Bumblebees because they make honey!'

Counting and writing numbers is really important when working with insects and animals. Can you write number 1-20 and recall the order they go in?

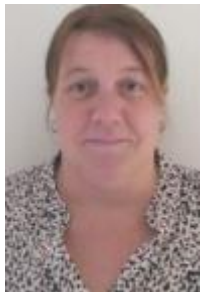

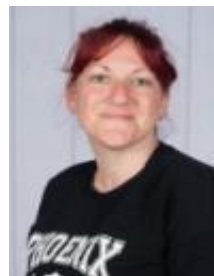


