Maths

We continue to work on counting and writing numbers throughout all our work

Can you write number 1-10 / 1-30 / 1-100 and recall the order they go in?

Search for as many 2D and 3D shapes as you can in the house and garden. Use money when out in the community, looking at prices and the value of different coins.

English

Our English work this term is all about animals.

Get out and about and enjoy walks looking for animals and their habitats. Listen for sounds when out and about and play sound bingo.

Read together as many times as you can in a week! Discuss the character, plot and setting and talk about the job of the author and illustrator. Look through non fiction books about animals and compile facts.
