Maths

Number

- Listen to Jack Hartmann count to 50 by 1's forwards and backwards video on YouTube
- Try to learn how to use a number line correctly, e.g. $1+2$ we start on one and then do 2 jumps.

Shapes

- Try to watch a range of 2d and 3d shapes videos on YouTube, recapping on what the shapes are called, and how many sides each shape has. (Hopscotch and The Singing Walrus have great videos/songs about these).
- Explore different objects in house, can your child name the shape of these objects?

UAS

- Try to sequence the days of the week, and the months of the year.
- Try to identify something you do at different times throughout the day, e.g. breakfast before school, brushing teeth morning and night.

Literacy

Our phonics scheme, Read write Inc, has enabled students to become much more engaged with their reading. Books should come home on a weekly basis (if your child accesses this) and books should be added for homework on a weekly basis on the Oxford Owl website.
